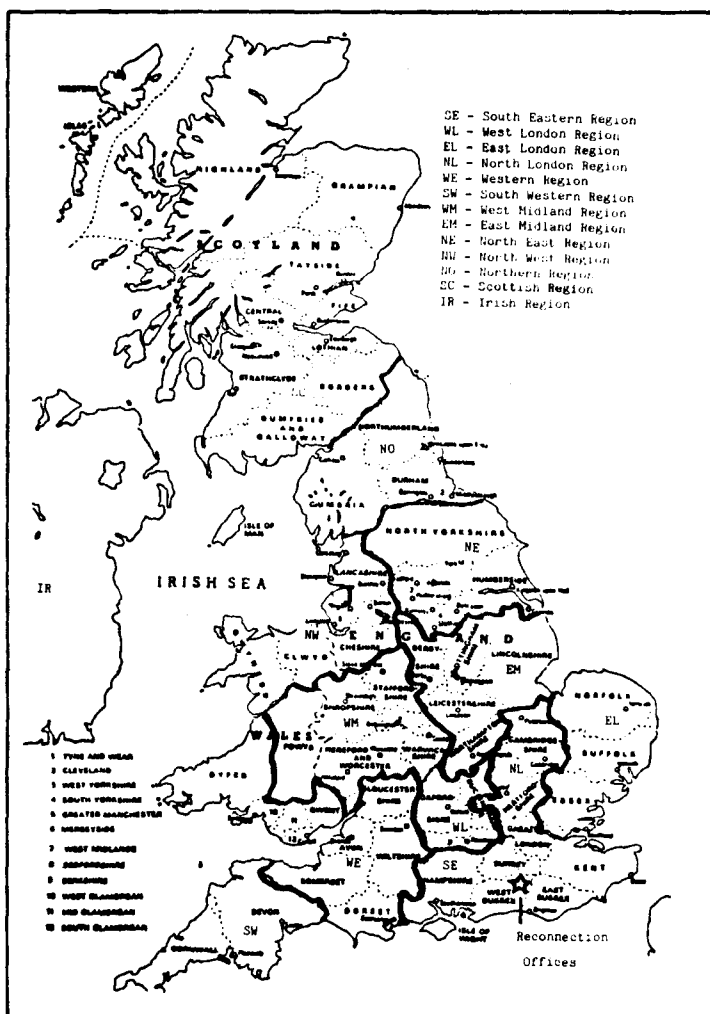
Keep a good comm line in, as this gives us power never before known.

More Graduates than Church

The feeling in the UK Independent Field can only be described as enthusiastic with the news that since the beginning of the year the Independent Movement has produced more products than the Church.

A recent list of completions from the two Advance Ability Centres and some of the other producing Centres can be found inside the back page. The list is impressive indeed.

More Advance Levels

We recently visited Sunderland and what a new group they have there! The Org has about two of the original staff members left. The rest of them joined the Independent Group.

The statistic all the while there was an Org, was no-one OT in Sunderland. Since the new group has formed up, there are now 9 AA3 completions (31 advance level completions) in Sunderland. As Bov Allen, the OT Committee Chairman of the region, explained "Not bad for a bunch of stalled clears".

The OT Committees in the UK, started originally by John Attack, have now been organised into regional areas as you can see by the Map. It is the intention to have a fully functioning committee in each regional area. Each Committee has as one of its major projects "giving assistance to any Independent who wants to set up a Delivery Centre".

Trained auditors in the field have grabbed the bull by the horns and simply started auditing. The amount of auditing going on is phenomenal. We did a count of graduates from the Independents and compared it with graduates from the church and came up with this month's headline.

The Whole Bridge up to, and including, AA7

With the two AACs delivering up to and including AA7 (Solo NOTS) it means that any UK or European Scientologist can get the full bridge with ease and with prices they can afford.

INDEPENDENT WINS CASE, AT WHAT COST?

The recent custody case fought in the Royal Courts of Justice resulted in the worst press for Scientology since 1968. In the summing up the Judge spent ten minutes on the custody details and then over an hour slating Scientology.

The result was blazed as headlines in every major newspaper the next day. The church have now appealed so it looks like

we will see, in the future, another dirty laundry report in the press.

The lesson to be learned by both sides is plain to see. This custody situation could have been sorted out by some good old communication, the universal solvent. The practise of disconnection prevents communication. Both sides must overcome this insanity and get comm flowing again.

"It is not necessary that a field auditor has great sums of money to finance his activity. All SUCCESSFUL Scientology activities have financed themselves. In extreme, an auditor with no pcs to keep him going can get a job and run a group evenings until the income of the group activity makes the job unnecessary.

The keynote of handling any area is to BRING ORDER. Every time you put some order into a pc or a group, or society, a little confusion blows off. Ignore the confusion. It is transitory. Order is not. It STAYS. Therefore the more ORDER (not necessarily the more ACTIVITY) you put into things the more continuance you have. This is new data, extremely important and should be carefully gone over again and again and applied. It is data that bring wins in a society, a group or a pc. Bring a little order.

Get the pc to see that he can bring order into his affairs. Ask him bluntly, "What order could you bring into your life?" And his case will start resolving. The highest ability of a thetan is to BRING ORDER. Therefore, orderly processing brings results, disorderly processing does not. All an ARC break is is a disorder.

What order then can a trained auditor bring into his area? Into his own life? Into his pc's? Into his group? THAT is the question worth answering.

The confusion that flies off when the order is entered in seems so IMPORTANT to many auditors that they Q and A with it. They stop pursuing order and start pursuing confusion. NEVER change from order to disorder just because confusion blows off. Let the confusion GO. If you want it all gone, just put more ORDER into it.

EDITORIAL

Change of Editorship

We felt, before we introduced ourselves to you as the new joint editors, that we should give a little of the history of the editorship of Reconnection.

The first three issues were edited by John Atack who was also the main force behind setting up the OT Committees in the UK. The task was taken up by Ron Biggs for issues 4 and 5 and the large bumper issue last month was edited by John Ablett.

Our sincere thankyou to those gentlemen who (we now know) sweated late into the night to make it happen.

Educated Eds?

Your present editors are Martin Ruston and Malcolm McPherson.

Martin found Scientology in 1964 and is currently on AA5 and was on the SH Special Briefing Course on leaving the Church. He worked in Australian Orgs in Division 3 and Division 6. Since that time he has been an active Field Scientologist. His latest claim to fame is his setting up of Ability Meters International and the launch of the Mark 7 Ability Meter. (Full review of the Mark 7 in next issue - Other ED)

Malcolm contacted Scientology the week after he graduated his Science degree at London University in 1966. He spent 3 years in London Org on staff, holding almost every post. He did the Briefing Course at St Hill in 1970 and then audited and CSed at Saint Hill. He then was recruited into the Sea Org and joined staff at Flag. He became Class VIII interning at Flag, and auditing and CSing directly under LRH. When in Tech at Flag he wrote the Expanded Dianetic Case History Bulletins (with Billy Strasser) and the Auditor Admin HCOBs (so now you know who to blame). He was also trained on the FEBC and ESTO materials for some special Executive and Qual Flag missions. After a spell as a "Program Chief" doing data evaluations, he was sent in 1975 by Diana Hubbard on a special Flag Mission to set up Groups in the UK. You may remember "Captain McPherson" rushing around the UK. His current field project is again at the lower end of the bridge setting up Field Auditors with a new marketing approach that will (don't say it) BLOW YOUR MIND. (Full write up on this program in next issue - Other ED)

Purpose of Magazine

The first thing we had to determine was what RECONNECTION is really all about. We had a meeting at the point of changeover with the old Editors and attempted to glean what we were supposed to be doing. We hope we have carried on enough of the tradition of the magazine. The first policy we decided on was to try to get the magazine out every month at the beginning of the month. This one has in fact run late and we apologize for that. To tell you the truth we didn't realize the enormity of the task. We are however getting more organised.

The major purpose of the magazine is to get the Independent Field fully connected and fully informed as to what is going on, no matter from which viewpoint. An OT Committee — Its major activities

At a recent meeting of the OT Committee East Grinstead Joyce Barnes was elected as the new Chairman. At that meeting Julian Bell went through the major activities of an OT Committee. We thought it would be worth mentioning these in our column as we know that many OTs are getting together into Committees in every area of the country.

We list these activities possibly in the order of importance

1. To get all known Scientologists in the area contacting each other and getting into comm. Getting all OTs together into a committee.
2. Getting a group together of all known Scientologists in the area and as a first step letting them debrief on the situation with regard to the Church and with regard to the Independent movement.
3. Assisting in getting repayment cycles complete so the person can end cycle with the Org and start afresh, in a new unit of time.
4. Encouraging all Scientologists in the area to get up the bridge to OT now that services are widely available and at reasonable prices. This especially applies to all stalled Clears that are sitting in the non interference area.
5. Assisting any trained auditors to get auditing again.
6. Assisting in getting a functioning auditing and training centre set up in the area so courses and auditing are locally available.
7. Building up a library of materials in the area, so the technology is not lost.
8. Assisting the OT Committee UK in any of its 3rd and 4th dynamic OT projects.

GROUP PROCESSING

From "Group Dianetics" in the book NOTES ON THE LECTURES

"These tenets which are delineated here actually constitute a discovery about groups comparable to the discovery of engrams in individuals.

The clearing of such a moment of turbulation is done simply by exposing all facets of it to the general view of all the individuals who compose the group.

This effort at processing will be utterly defeated should the auditor to the group pay any attention whatsoever to the consideration the public or other groups may have for the group, to the reputation of any individual involved in the moment of emergency, or to any idea that members of the group itself may grossly be upset by the discovery of certain facts about its members.

The characteristic point of this turmoil or turbulence, the engram of the group, is that it contains suppressed or out-of-sight information. If at any moment the auditor to the group suppresses information or colours it in any way, some of that engram is going to remain, and actually a situation is entered here where the engram is left in a state of restimulation where it can do more damage than it could have, had it never been run. The auditor to the group must be composed of persons fully schooled in the ideals, rationale and ethic of the group, and whose integrities are not questioned by the group. The whole key-note of the group auditor is honesty and truth - uncoloured, unvarnished and unsuppressed data.

In this way a good auditing job can be done. The auditor of the group is discovering what has been done to the group and is running it. There is no need of going over and over one of these engrams beyond exposing the information thoroughly and competently to the view of all and permitting all members of the group to discuss that information as they wish." L. RON HUBBARD

It's obvious that we need to audit our own group engram. What about taking responsibility for the engrams that have been inflicted upon society in the name of Scientology? Is it enough to say "That was the GO" or "The CMO"

Some people feel that it's enough to simply audit and train. The majority should do that, but there is also the difficult task of gaining public acceptance and making up the damage we've caused.

It isn't done by infiltrating government agencies, nor by adopting a superior attitude to "WOGS", nor by maltreatment of staff.

We have to admit that the group we belonged to had third dynamic psychotic breaks, and the Church's "We don't do that anymore" arguments won't be very useful to us. We should tell the whole truth about our group. We should align ourselves

RESIGNATION FROM THE CHURCH OF SCIENTOLOGY

Dear Friend,

For many of you reading this letter, Scientology represents that breath of fresh air that, sometime in the past, has given meaning and direction to your lives.

We have all striven to achieve the aims of Scientology, and looked up and forward along the road to Clear and OT, looked forward to those increased abilities, the increased freedom and the increased awareness.

In the Creed of the Church of Scientology it states:

"We of the Church believe:

That all men have inalienable rights to think freely, to talk freely, to write freely their own opinions and to counter or utter or write upon the opinions of others."

This letter is in the spirit of our own creed, and is directed to all those who have crossed the line to the splinter groups, to the very many Scientologists who are sitting on the fence wondering which way to turn and especially to those dear friends who are battling away on staff still believing, somehow, that it will come out alright.

Starting in 1981 there was a sudden purge within the Church and about 200 top executives and many lesser executives of the Church were declared suppressive.

As an ex-Flag Staff Member and Missionaire and having a staff record dating back to 1966, I knew pretty well all the staff members that had been declared. I knew their record, I knew their statistics, I knew their hard work, sweat and toil, I knew their dedication.

And I knew they ALL weren't and couldn't be suppressive!

For example:

Here in the UK our own "Hoppy" was declared. He was loved dearly by all Scientologists throughout the country. His statistics as a staff member with over 15 years' service were impeccable.

In truth, before Hoppy was declared, he actually took himself off post as Commanding Officer and routed himself to the Project Force. *Reason:* He was being asked to declare his own juniors, and carry out many more destructive actions within his continent. At first he obeyed as he thought the orders were coming directly from LRH. After some weeks he realised that LRH just couldn't be the source of such insanity.

It was at this time that Jules and I decided to investigate what was happening within the Church and it is the result of that two years of fact-finding that we are issuing this resignation today.

There are so many facts available pertaining to the current situation that the sheer weight of paper will not permit us to outline them all here. Anyone reading this is welcome to contact us and be given the *full* history.

We will, however, try to outline the salient points of what is happening within and without the Church.

1. LRH, although officially off the management lines of the Church since 1966 for legal reasons, had always kept a strong eye on the running of the Church and his advices had been well taken up by the top executives. These advices were usually in the form of personally-written dispatches. The number and frequency of these handwritten dispatches being received by the Church top management slowed to almost zero during 1979.

2. Many bulletins and policy from 1978 were written by aides and went to LRH, were approved and WERE ISSUED AS THOUGH COMING FROM LRH HIMSELF.

Example:

The 23 October 1983 HCO Bulletin concerning the redefinition of real overt was written by Phoebe Maurer.

3. In 1976 a compilation unit was set up to cull data from the many advices issued to various staffs during LRH's long career and when enough data was available a policy or bulletin was issued. Please note however that, although such issues are LRH writings, the materials are often out of sequence and have the additional liability of being wrongly dated. The significance and importance of this compilations unit will become apparent.

4. Since the middle of 1980 there has been a definite and dramatic change of top Management of the Church. Since that time there has been major policy changes:

- a) Monthly price rises abolished by LRH in 1979 were reintroduced.
- b) Sec Checking abolished by LRH in 1968 were reintroduced especially for all winning and flourishing OTs.

- c) The practise of disconnection cancelled by LRH in 1968 was reintroduced.
- d) The Guardians Office was disbanded and on information and belief we understand that all files on outside agencies who had attacked Scientology (CIA, FBI, INTERPOL, PSYCHIATRY etc) were destroyed while Intelligence Files on Scientologists were retained.
- e) Although it is a tenet of the faith of Scientology that all secrets, sins and crimes divulged to auditors and ministers of the Church in confessional circumstances shall remain absolutely confidential and that absolution shall be given for such actions confessed, a practise of "crime culling" is currently being used by the Church. Information so obtained is being used in Committees of Evidence and lately in outside legal actions against the person although strictly forbidden by LRH in policy. (HCO POLICY 26 August 1968 SECURITY CHECKS ABOLISHED).
- f) "Fair Game" has been reintroduced and vigorously practised against persons who are not in agreement with the present Church Management. This includes the practise of harrassment and a host of other "dirty tricks".
- g) The Church Management structure has been brought under a new Corporation called the Religious Technology Corporation (RTC). This Corporation was apparently handed over the copyrights and trademarks of Scientology. The document outlining this transfer purported to be signed by LRH. The legality of this document and the authenticity of the 'LRH' signature are being contested and are now very much in question. To make this document legal the signing by LRH had to be witnessed by a Notary Public, but instead of being an independent Notary, as would be usual in the case of such an important document, it was David Miscavige, now the top executive of the Church and RTC!

5. The new management, since gaining control, has declared nearly 2000 dedicated and longstanding staff members. The change of operating basis of this new management since 1981 has caused such an uproar in the Scientology "field" that literally thousands of Scientology students and pcs (many long-term dedicated Scientologists) have publically resigned.

6. The staffs of the Organisations and the operation of the Orgs have been kept together by hoodwinking the staffs that LRH is very much in command and that everything is expanding better than ever.

This has been done by issuing the occasional bulletin and policy letter from LRH. This is where the compilations unit comes into its own. Some of the bulletins do contain LRH advices and some are just written by others.

Example:

The Pain/Sex Bulletin July 1982 was definitely NOT written by LRH.

Also the Ron's Journals (RJ36 and RJ38) have been produced by voice synthesis. Impossible you might say. In today's highly technical world not impossible at all.

We have documented evidence of how this deceit has been perpetrated.

7. It was inevitable that with the numbers deserting the Church that some of the OTs would have the guts to set up alternative independent centres delivering the technology. These have sprung up all over the world and contrary to current Church propoganda are doing well.

8. However, the Church Management have created a classic third party situation. They have stirred up and incensed the staffs that these new independents are "squirrels" and doing the Org in and should be destroyed. So Scientologists are fighting and suing Scientologists.

9. What has happened to the production of Clears and OTs? Well you may ask. It now costs in the Church £5,000 to train to Class IV. It costs £65,000 to go from the bottom of the bridge to OT7. (With the L processes that would be £90,000).

Again, contrary to Church propoganda, the number of actual OTs that are being produced at this moment is pretty minimal within the Church. The numbers of OTs being produced in the Independent groups is increasing. However, the New Church Management is trying to wipe these Independent Centres out.

10. Which really brings us to our final point. Who is running the Church and what do YOU do to handle the scene?

Whoever is running the Church sure doesn't want to see a planet full of OTs. There is a danger that prices will go up preventing any more OTs being produced, the elimination of the Independent Centres so that there is no alternative and the final winding up of the Church with the Government ending up holding the copyrights of Dianetics and Scientology. The final result would be no-one on the planet being able to practice Scientology. Good plan eh?

We hold documentary evidence here which gives a fair idea of who IS running the Church and if you contact us we can give you all the background data on this.

If you are a Scientologist (just read the Aims of Scientology, the Creed of the Church, the Code of Honour and the Auditor's Code to determine this) then the first thing you must, must do is recognise that the only way to handle this is to apply the very basics of Scientology to the situation.

One of THE basics is ARC and the easiest to raise is C.

So look around and get in comm with each and every Scientologist you know. That means ALL of them. Yes, even your friends you had to shun in the name of the group. There are precious few of us anyway and declaring half of us taboo sure doesn't solve the situation.

If you're on staff, well, you are going to have to make up your own mind where it is at. For sure Scientology won't be wiped off the planet. Church or no Church. The buildings etc are a symbol of the subject but the subject itself transcends all material considerations.

"THE FOCAL POINT IS UPON SCIENTOLOGY NOT ITS ORGANISATIONS OR AUDITORS OR PERSONALITIES" LRH Tech Vol II Page 132.

Get yourself in a position where you can comm without fear and then comm. It will work out. It has for us. No-one can set aside or refuse you the Bridge. It will be there. LRH didn't train and audit all us OTs for nothing you know!

Jules and I are free to see you at any time for an open and relaxed comm.

CULT FATHER LOSES PLEA TO KEEP CHILDREN

THE decision to "rescue" two children from the clutches of the Scientology cult, branded "corrupt, sinister and dangerous" by a High Court judge, was backed by two Appeal Court judges yesterday.

They refused the plea by the father, a Scientologist, to overturn Mr Justice Latey's ruling in July that the children must be handed over to their mother to start a new life in Australia.

The 32-year-old father said the judge had gone too far in his attack on the church and its founder L. Ron Hubbard.

And he claimed this had affected the judge's discretion in deciding what was in the best interest of the children, a boy of 10 and girl of eight.

Mr Justice Latey described the practices of Hubbard and his helpers as "grimly reminiscent of the ranting and bullying of Hitler and his henchmen." He said their brainwashing of children at an early age was "training for slavery."

Lord Justice DUNN sitting with Lord Justice PURCHAS agreed that the judge had expressed himself in "strong and forthright terms." But he said that was no ground for challenging his decision.

He said there was ample evidence that the father had lied on occasion, and the judge could not rely on assurances that the children would be protected from Scientology until they were old enough to make up their own minds.

The children have been living with the father since the couple split up in 1978. But the judges ordered them to be handed over to the 28-year-old mother on Saturday at noon.

Scales tipped

She will take them back to Australia with her new husband, a 36-year-old art dealer, at the beginning of next week.

The father, whose new wife is expecting a child in October, was refused leave to appeal to the House of Lords. But he was told he could have reasonable access to the children.

Mr Justice Latey had found that the children were happy and well looked after by the father but he said it was inevitable that if they stayed with him they would be brought up as Scientologists.

Lord Justice Dunn said the Scientology factor "tipped the scales" in favour of the mother. The judge had to balance the risks and to do so he had to make findings about Scientology.

Those findings were not chal-

lenged in the appeal court. "The judge plainly felt strongly that these children were at risk."

Mr Justice Latey had called Hubbard a charlatan.

He had said: "Scientology is both immoral and socially obnoxious. In my judgment it is corrupt, sinister and dangerous. It is corrupt because it is based on lies and deceit and has as its real objective money and power for Mr Hubbard, his wife and those close to him at the top."

Infamous practices

"It is sinister because it indulges in infamous practices both to its adherents who do not toe the line unquestioningly and to those outside who criticise or oppose it."

"It is dangerous because it is out to capture people, especially children and impressionable young people, and indoctrinate and brainwash them so that they become the unquestioning captives and tools of the cult, withdrawn from ordinary thought, living and relationships with others."

The mother and father married in 1973 when both were Scientologists. They divorced in 1979 and the mother broke away from the cult.

RELIGIOUS SECT'S FOUR ON COUNCIL

Four members of a controversial religious sect will be returned unopposed as parish councillors for the village of Herringewell, Suffolk, today.

It will be the village's first council election. The four live in the manor house taken over by the Medina Rajneesh sect as its British HQ in 1982. It is home to 140 of the followers of Bhagwan Shree Rajneesh.

Ma Prem Diana, Ma Simant, Swami Anand Amrito and Swami Anand Neerava have been nominated to the council in their English names: Diana Grant, Derek Hawkins, Christopher Scott and Gillian Westley.

NEWS FROM AROUND

David reckoned that the last two months have been particularly busy for the area and that the number of people joining the Independent Movement has escalated just recently.
